.... The veneration of the cross.

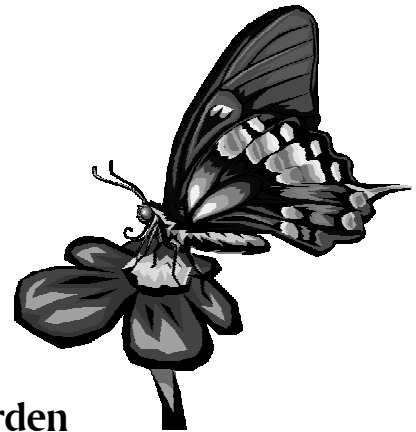
.... The proclamation of the passion
